Our program offers extensive educational evaluations to give parents and teachers a better understanding of the academic and/or social development needs of a student. In addition, we offer personalized educational programs and tutoring for students.

At SOAR Regional Diagnostic & Learning Center, we seek to provide all of our students with a new opportunity for success by cultivating the cognitive and non-cognitive skills needed to become a productive member of their home school communities. We take pride in our ability to collaborate closely with families and referring schools to design a comprehensive plan that addresses the educational, social/emotional, and transitional needs of each student. Careful consideration and planning are undertaken in determining which educational environment is best suited to meet a student's unique needs in his or her home school district.

Our enhanced services include but are not limited to:

Summer Programming – A 5-week placement to help determine eligibility for the next school year or continue services forward from the end of the current school year.

Credit Recovery – The SOAR program can be adapted to assist students who need credit recovery in order to progress. Flexible scheduling is available based on the needs of the student and district.

Diagnostic Placement – Up to a 45-day placement to determine Special Education eligibility and provide educational screenings, clinical evaluations, and recommendations.

Interim Educational Placement – Placement for students who need additional time to transition to their next educational setting or need academic support while serving a long-term suspension or expulsion.

Pricing and scheduling are based on district and student requirements for success. Favorable rates are available for student transportation.
